Class Descriptions:

Regular Classes:

Regular classes are open to those dogs that will be jumping their regular measured height or one jump height higher.

Specials Classes:

These classes are open to those dogs that wish to jump one jump height lower. A dog may no longer compete in the Regular class after it has competed in Specials.

Veterans Classes:

These classes are open to those dogs that are seven years of age or older, or Specials class dogs that are five years of age that have competed in Specials for a minimum of one calendar year. Veterans may jump one height (single drop) or two heights (double drop) lower than the registered height assigned on their AAC ID card.

Equipment: All equipment conforms to AAC specifications. Electronic timing and a breakaway tire will be used.

Benching/Crating: Crating will be available in designated areas around the ring. Competitors may also crate out of their vehicles. Although the parking area is close, it is out of view of the ring area. The site has ample natural shade, which can be augmented with shade screens. Shade tents will be permitted in a designated area. Please respect physical distancing when setting up and within your shade tent.

<u>Camping</u>: There is no camping on-site. There are a number of campgrounds within a half hour drive of the site.

Equipment Familiarization:

Equipment familiarization will be offered Friday, June 21, 2024 from 2 to 5 p.m., at a cost of \$5.00 per run for 60 seconds. No jumps/levels. Tunnels, contacts and weaves only. Please sign up for your equipment familiarization runs on the entry form. NOTE: Equipment familiarization is open only to dogs competing in the Regionals.

Steeplechase:

This game demonstrates the dog's ability to run and jump at high speeds while maintaining control on the A-frame and weave poles. This class is open to all dogs eligible to compete in other AAC qualifying events at the Starters, Advanced or Masters Level. A Steeplechase run will be offered on Friday, June 21, 2024 beginning at 6 p.m., judged by Craig Peters. This Steeplechase is open to all eligible AAC-registered dogs, as well as those competing in the Regionals Championships. Please sign up for Steeplechase on the entry form.

Prizes and Awards:

Trophies will be awarded for 1st place and placement rosettes for 2nd thru 6th place for the two-day aggregate, as well as Nationals qualifying ribbons. In addition, AIM will be offering Saturday and Sunday placement awards for each event/class. Qualifying and placement ribbons will also be available for Steeplechase.


Site Food:

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in Season (BIS) are allowed to compete at Regionals. Owners of BIS and other competitors need to familiarize themselves with the rules applying to them, that notwithstanding, below are the highlights of the rules applying to BIS at AAC trials:

- Handlers must notify the Trial Secretary that they will be running a BIS as soon as it is known to them;
- Handlers must minimize exposure of their BIS to other dogs and limit their movement about the grounds;
- Handlers with a BIS may still opt to receive a refund of their entries and not compete:
- Competitors will be notified that there is a BIS on site;
- Competitors will provide a protective mat for use at the start line;
- BIS will run at the end of the class (in a group if there is more than one);
- "BIS" will be noted next to the dog's name on the gate sheet so that other competitors, the judge and the ring crew are aware:
- BIS will be provided and expected to use a separate potty area;
- BIS must wear protective panties at all times (including running on course), except when they are within the designated relief area.

JUNIOR HANDLERS

"Junior Handler" at the Regionals refers to a handler that is 18 years of age or younger as of December 2024. At Regional competitions, Junior Handlers will have a reduced number of points necessary to qualify for Nationals. The points are the same as for senior/disabled handlers. Instead of 350 points, a Junior Handler will only require a total of 300 points to qualify for Nationals. There is no change to scoring or judging, only the total points needed.

Important Note to Steeplechase Competitors: We will need all competitors in the Steeplechase Class to also volunteer to work a portion of that class. Please fill out the volunteer form and indicate what position you are able to volunteer in for Friday's Steeplechase class. Please also indicate that you will be running a dog in that event so that we can separate those sheets from our other volunteer positions. Thank you!

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry by AAC and Agility in Manitoba (the "**Organizing Club**") and the opportunity to have the Dog participate, compete in and/or be judged at this event or trial (the "**Event**"), I, the undersigned, agree as follows:

- 1) I certify that I am the actual owner of the Dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the Dog and that the Dog is not a hazard to persons, property or other dogs.
- 2) I agree that AAC or the Organizing Club for the Event may refuse my entry for any reason that it deems to be sufficient.
- 3) I understand and acknowledge that participating in the Event carries certain risks, including, but not limited to injuries (including serious injuries and death) to myself, the Dog, another dog under my control or persons attending as my guests (my "Related Parties"), damage to property and other losses. I waive any and all claims that I have or may have in the future against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue AAC, the Organizing Club or any of the directors, executives, committees, representatives, employees, volunteers or agents of either AAC or the Organizing Club (the "Personnel") for any injury, death, property damage or other loss that I or my Related Parties sustain due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty, statutory or otherwise, or mistakes or errors of judgement of any kind.
- 4) I assume full responsibility for the conduct of myself and my Related Parties during the entirety of the Event. I agree to indemnify and save harmless AAC, the Organizing Club and the Personnel from and against any and all claims that may be made against them or costs, fees, expenses or liability (including, without limitation, lawyers' fees on a solicitor and own client basis) incurred by AAC, the Organizing Club or the Personnel that may arise due to:
 - (a) Any act or omission of myself, my Related Parties or any party for whom I am liable at law; or
 - (b) Aggressive behaviour by the Dog or any other dog under my control.
- 5) I have read, and do understand the rules of competition and the additional rules (if any) appearing in the trial schedule for the Event, as well as the policies of AAC pertaining to discipline (collectively, the "Rules"). I agree to abide by the Rules and to conduct myself and the Dog in accordance with the Rules. I understand that myself and/or the Dog may be subject to disciplinary procedures or sanctions for breach of the Rules and agree to respect and be bound by any disciplinary decision made by AAC.
- 6) I understand that AAC and/or the Organizing Club may, in the course of administering the Event or conducting its activities generally, collect, use or disclose my personal information and that any personal information collected, used or disclosed by AAC and/or the Organizing Club will be treated in accordance with AAC policy and applicable privacy and personal information laws. I hereby consent to the collection, use and disclosure by AAC and/or the Organizing Club of my personal information.
- 7) I have been given the opportunity to read and understand the terms of this Agreement before signing it, and have in fact done so. I understand that by signing this Agreement, I am restricting my legal rights and I sign this Agreement voluntarily and of my own free will.

The Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA) requires that consent be obtained for the collection and use of personal information. The information collected by Agility In Manitoba will be used for: registering and listing competitors in agility events, submitting results, as required by the sanctioning body, and contacting competitors by email, mail or phone for future agility events such as trials and seminars. The information will be retained by Agility In Manitoba for a period of two years and disposed of in a manner that ensures information protection.
